



**Location:** Komodo, Indonesia  
**Reference:** I2

The island of Komodo lies to the east of Bali, between Jakarta, the largest city of Indonesia, and the continent of Australia. It has one of the richest diversities of marine life and together with Rinca, ranked as one of the most exciting diving destinations in the world.

To get there you need to fly from Bali to Labuanbajo, where most liveonboards depart off.

### HIGHLIGHTS

When one thinks of Komodo, the large sometimes 3 meter long lizard with its bacteria filled forked tongue comes to mind. These lizards are deadly and have known to cause death to humans. Thank GOD komodo dragons are not swimmers.

Diving in Komodo can be dangerous as currents are sometimes unpredictable and can change direction without warning. Despite this divers still flock to Komodo and the surrounding areas of Rinca and Flores for pure exciting diving.

Komodo can only be covered by liveonboards and due to the unpredictable weather conditions it is not possible to cover the 50+ dive sites in one trip as sites are far apart.

Almost all species of tropical pelagic are found here and in large numbers.

### ACCOMMODATION

It is possible to stay in Labuanbajo and dive Northern Komodo but the exciting dive sites are all to the South where no accommodation is found.

### GOD's EXPERIENCE

You need to be well prepared to face up to 6 knots of current, unpredictable cold water (temperature can drop several degrees during a dive) due to the meeting of currents.

### BEST SEASON

Generally good weather all year round as some areas are sheltered such as the North side of Kode. However the sea is rough in the middle of the year for the Southern islands of Komodo and Rinca.

### OTHER ACTIVITIES

Purely diving unless you intend on researching/studying the komodo dragon.

### PACKAGE COST

USD 800 to 1,800 ex Labuanbajo for 6/5 nights LOB. Price ranges depending on standard of dive boat, route covered and season.
