



**Location:** Pulau Weh  
**Reference:** I8

Situated on the northwestern tip of Sumatra, a 350 meter wide channel fills the gap between Pulau Weh and its reef-encircled sister island, Pulau Rubiah where some excellent drift dives can be had. Pulau Weh also offers fantastic wrecks, drops offs and an amazing array of marine life. Most dive sites are reachable by boat from Iboih (pleasant fishing village) or Gapang beach.

### HIGHLIGHTS

WW II "Sophie Rickmers" wreck is a must for experienced deep wreck divers. For those who are not too keen venturing deep, the coral formations here are amazing; some divers have also nicknamed Pulau Weh as "the moray capital of Asia", where all sorts of morays can be found from the giant morays to the beautiful spotted honeycomb moray.

### BEST SEASON

April to November.

Snorkeling and swimming, sea sports hire ocean kayaks, sail boats and wind surfs.
