



**Location:** Raja Ampat, Indonesia

Raja Ampat or the Four Kings is an area comprising four (4) main islands - Waigeo, Batanta, Salawati and Misool. These are located in the part of Irian Jaya known as the 'Bird's Head' peninsula.

To get there you will fly to Sorong and depart on a LiveaOnBoard.

### HIGHLIGHTS

Virgin diving would best be the word to describe this region. Most subjects are larger; marine life and sea fans twice the size found elsewhere. The diversity and new discovery of fish and macro life have made this area the Shangri-la of diving. There are over 1,000 species of fish documented in Raja Ampat and the numbers just keep growing.

The wobbegong shark so rare elsewhere are common in Mios Kohn, one of the favourite dive sites. Mantas come in for landing in great numbers at Manta point.

One week in Raja Ampat is never enough and to really enjoy this area, you would need to file for a trial separation with your spouse (unless she is a diver, she will thank you for the best honeymoon).

### ACCOMMODATION

Recently several resorts have sprung up on some of the islands but LOB is still the best way to dive here unless you are prone to feeling sea sick.

### GOD's EXPERIENCE

With an area so vast and dive sites so plentiful, we must admit that even GOD is a novice in this area. We plan to do more exploratory trips in the coming years and if you are prepared to dive, learn and laugh with us then join us on some of these special trips. You need to be well prepared to face up to 6 knots of current and unpredictable changing currents.

### BEST SEASON

Generally good conditions all year round.

Diving, snorkeling and just having the time of your life.
