Location: Tulamben, Bali

Tulamben is located on the eastern side of Bali, away from the tourist crowd. The drive from Kuta is about two hours.

Tulamben region includes the USAT Liberty wreck (voted one of the best and safest wreck diving in the World).

HIGHLIGHTS

Dve sites include the Drop Off of Tulamben, Coral garden, Alamanda and the macro heaven of Seraya.

Liberty wreck is a WWI cargo ship that sank in WWII, gunned down by the Japanese. The wreck is now the most popular dive site in Bali and sits at just 5 meters to about 30 meters. This 120 meter long wreck is encrusted with coral and is home to macro critters and hundreds of bumphead wrasses.

The Drop off is located at the south end of Tulamben Bay and is a wall dive with chance of seeing pelagic like sharks, mantas and mola-mola.

Coral garden is between the Wreck and the Drop Off; rich in coral and invertebrate life. Excellent for new divers as the shallow reef is only 10 meters in depth.

Alamanda is at the corner Tulamben bay and is very different from the other dive sites as it has a white sandy bottom with an array of hard corals. Sites are protected from currents but you need to go deep to enjoy the marine life.

Seraya is fast becoming a macro heaven as more and more new macro species are discovered each day. Ghost pipefish, mimic octopus, frogfish are common here.

BEST SEASON

You can dive Tulamben all year round.

PACKAGE COST

Price per person is about USD 675. It includes twin accommodation at the 4 Star Mimpri resort in Tulamben and one night in the 4.5 Star Ramayana resort near the Hard Rock Cafe in Kuta. Includes all land transfers, 9 boat dives in Tulamben areas and Seraya, packed lunches on boat and all dinner except last night in Kuta.
